

Immunization Attestation Form In Compliance with Oklahoma Statutes, §70-3244

Immunization Requirements for Brown Mackie College – Oklahoma City Students: Oklahoma state law requires that all new students who enroll full-time or part-time in an Oklahoma institution of higher education provide written documentation of vaccinations against hepatitis B, measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR).

Exemptions and Exceptions: State law allows that a signed, written statement from a licensed physician indicating the vaccine is medically contraindicated shall exempt a student from this requirement. Further, state law permits an exemption if administration of the vaccine conflicts with the student's moral or religious tenets and the student submits a signed statement to that effect or if the student is a minor, the student's parent or guardian provides a signed statement that administration of the vaccine conflicts with the parent or guardian's moral or religious tenets.
